NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

Fraser Highway Bridge at Nicomekl River Project

The City of Langley invites the public to attend a Public Information Meeting regarding the replacement of the existing bridge that crosses Fraser Highway at the Nicomekl River, located immediately east of the intersection at Langley Bypass and Fraser Highway.

The \$9 million project is jointly funded by the Government of Canada, the Province of British Columbia, TransLink and the City of Langley and will include the following:

- New 4-lane facility plus intersection turn lane;
- New bridge structure raised to avoid future flooding;
- Pedestrian sidewalk on both sides;
- Dedicated, directional bicycle lanes;
- Improved signage and street lighting; and,
- Access restriction at Old Yale Road and Fraser Highway.

Project representatives will provide a brief presentation of the project at 6:00 pm, followed by an opportunity for the public to have their questions answered.
